Your son/daughter has been selected to represent one of Burnaby North's Sports Teams. As a member of the team, please remember this is an extracurricular activity which is offered voluntarily by teachers, community coaches and sponsors of Burnaby North Secondary School.

Burnaby North is part of the Burnaby New West Athletic Association, and teams generally compete against other high schools from Burnaby and New Westminster. This said, teams may need to compete against other schools in the lower mainland as part of league and playoff commitments. Match and game schedules will be developed by league conveners, and the coach will provide your son/daughter with details as soon as possible. The coach is also responsible for arranging the practice schedule. Practice days and times may be consistent, but may also vary depending on the week.

Transportation to and from venues will be the responsibility of the student's parents/guardians.

Please refer to the athletics website, www.bnsathletics.ca for updated game and practice schedules, along with announcements on your team page.

Burnaby North's Athletic Program will receive a grant to assist in its operations; however, the amount of financial support is inadequate to meet the needs of the program. For this reason we ask student-athletes to pay a **User Fee** to help off-set the costs of league commitments, exhibition tournaments, officials, and the athletic banquets. PLEASE NOTE: As a new process of school money collection, this User Fee must be paid online. In some cases of legitimate financial need these costs will be waived by the Burnaby North Secondary School Athletic Department. Please advise your coach or Mrs. Oatway with a brief memo should you require support in this area.

In order to be ready to play, please take care of the following as soon as possible:

- 1) Complete all the forms in the attached package and return to your coach
- 2) Pay your athletic fee through School Cash Online
- 3) \$100 uniform deposit – 2 choices
 - a. Pay the uniform deposit online through school cash – once uniform is returned, the money will be reimbursed into your account
 - b. Bring Ms. Oatway a post-dated cheque for December 15th, 2021
- 4) Come to the sports centre any lunch hour with your receipt of payment & deposit (photo on form is ok, no hard copy required) and pick up your uniform from Ms. Oatway

Student-Athlete Participant Agreement

All participants of Burnaby School District athletic programs agree to abide by the following requirements when entering facilities and/or participating in school sport activities:

1. I agree to complete a health screening self-check prior to every team activity and will inform my coach immediately if I have experienced any COVID-19 symptoms in the last 14 days.
2. I agree to stay home if feeling sick or if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
3. I agree to adhere to the mask procedures for school sport as outlined in the regional or provincial COVID-19 health and safety guidelines/orders.
4. I agree to adhere to the transportation procedures as outlined in the regional or provincial COVID-19 health and safety guidelines.
5. I agree to sanitize my hands upon entering and exiting the facility, with soap and water or sanitizer.
6. I agree to practice correct respiratory etiquette at all times.
7. I agree to follow any sport specific guidelines that may be in place for my sport.
8. I agree to follow all equipment and facilities procedures communicated by my coach.
9. I agree to not share water bottles and personal equipment with others.
10. I agree to abide by all COVID-19 procedures and guidelines indicated for my participation in classes or on my team.
11. I understand that I may participate in games hosted at venues external to the school district and that these venues may establish additional health and safety guidelines. I agree to abide by all guidelines set forth by venues hosting competitions.
12. I understand that if I do not abide by the aforementioned procedures/guidelines, that I may lose the privilege to participate in school sports.
